


Signs of Heatstroke in Cats



Summer Safety Checklist for Pets



Put out multiple water bowls (refreshed multiple times daily)



Set up shaded areas on cool materials such as tile or stone



Run fans or air-conditioning during peak heat



No unnecessary travel or outdoor activity during peak heat hours



Keep cooling mats or damp towels available



Save emergency veterinary contacts



Draw window blinds or curtains during peak heat



Pet Insurance that covers heatstroke (like Knose!)



Ensure cross-ventilation (by opening two windows) across the house
